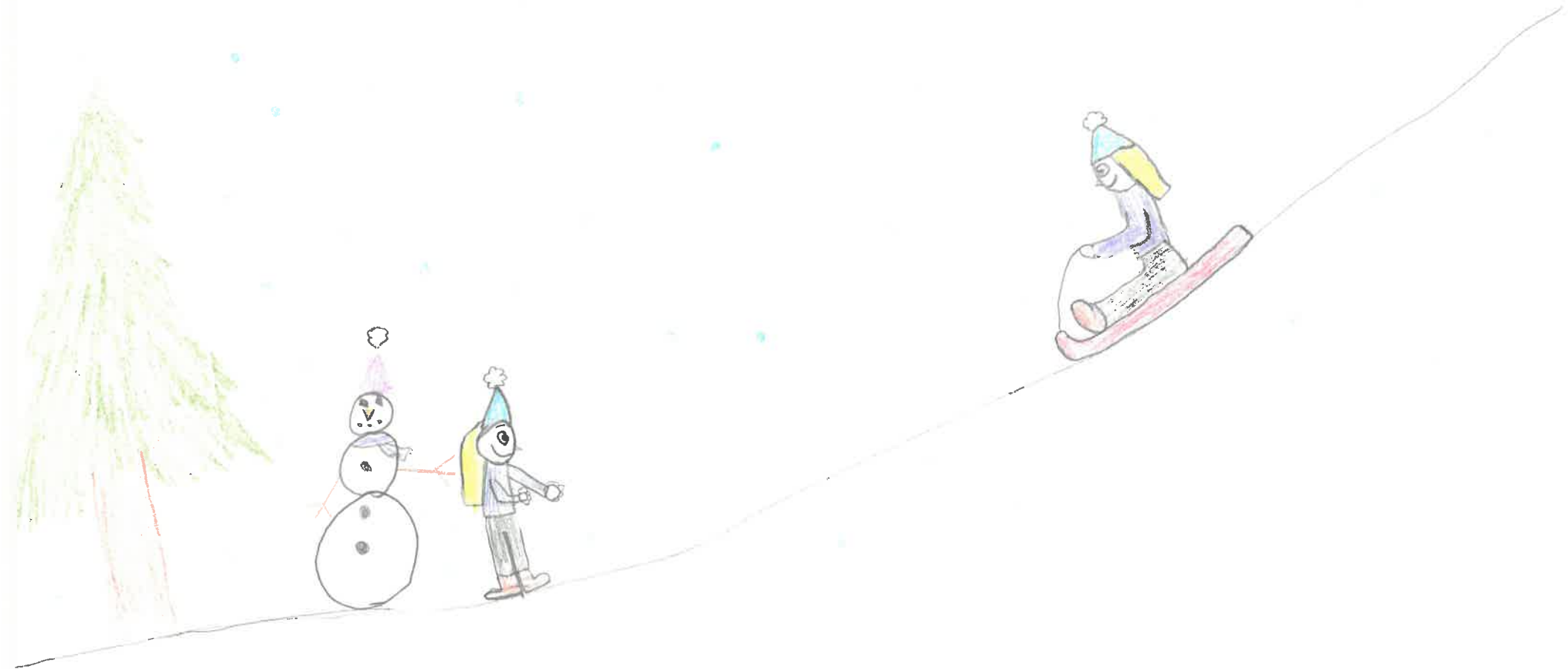




It's Saturday morning and I don't have

laughing, playing and having fun too!

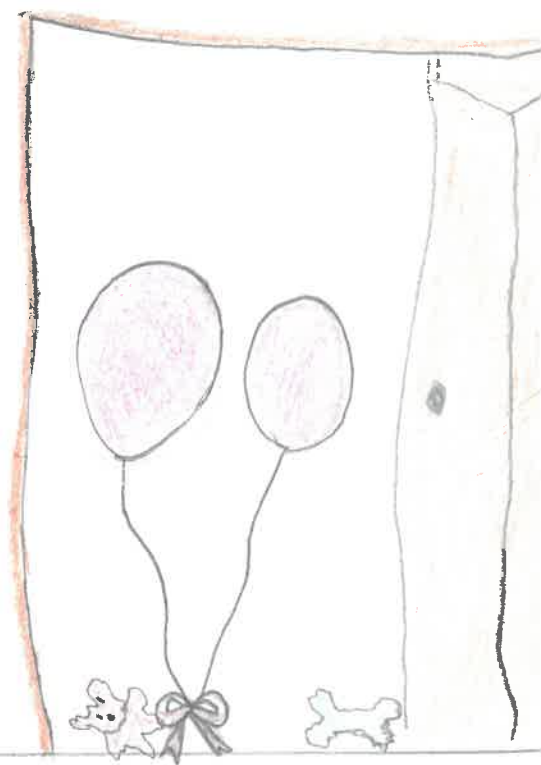
Dear mom and dad, I

is coming?

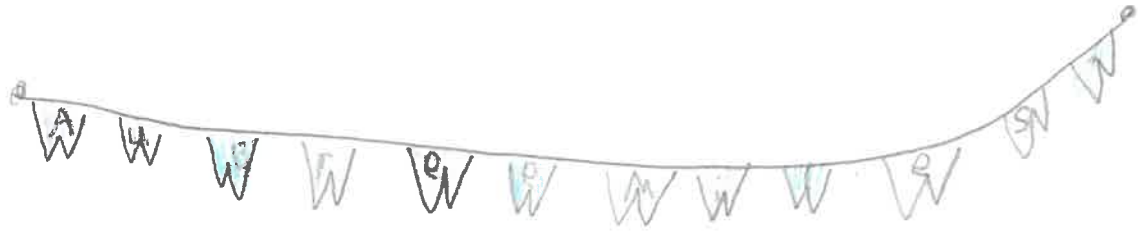


There's only two more days until Christmas, I

living room closet!

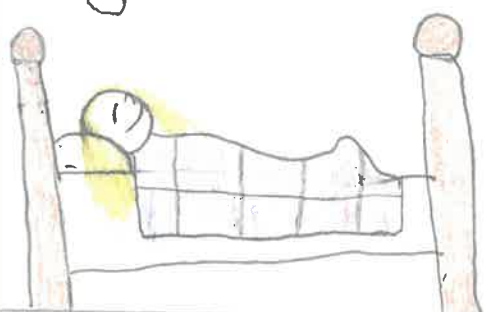


Could these toys be for my new little sister?

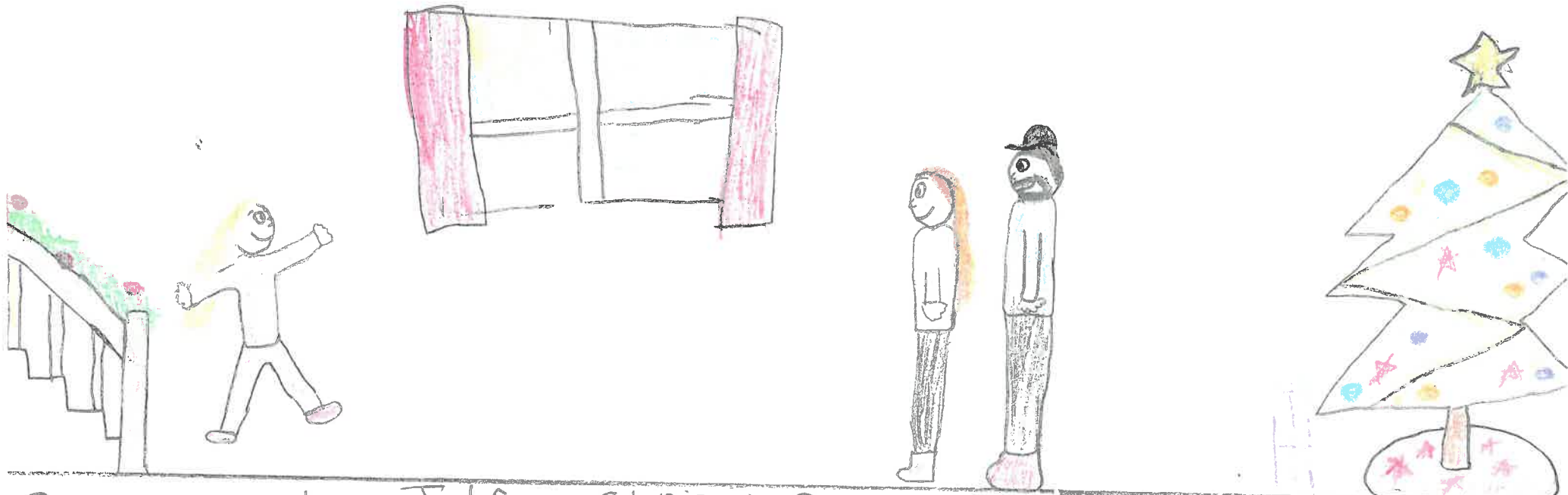




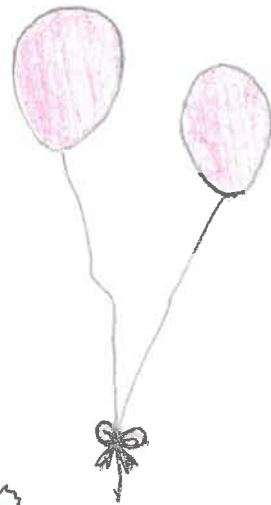
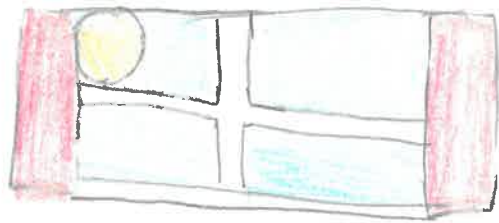
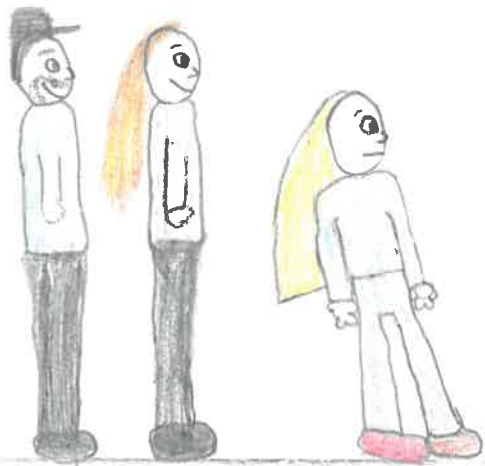

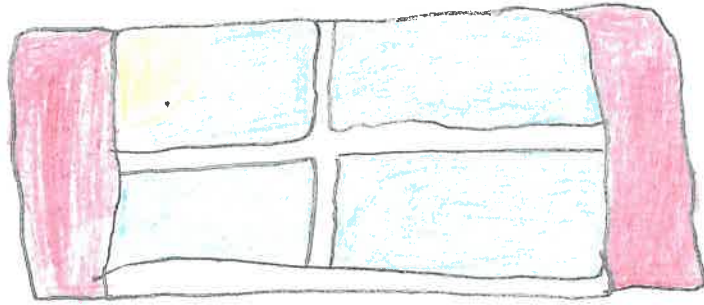
Finally, Christmas Eve and I can't hardly wait! All I can think about is getting a sister!



Oh yes! Its christmas morning! I ran so fast down the stairs to meet my new sister. My mom and dad were waiting for me by the tree.

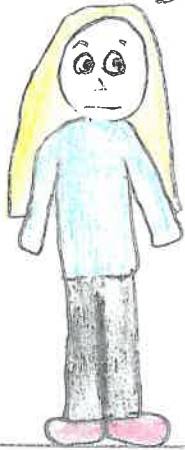
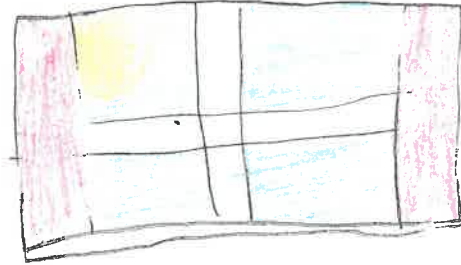


"Surprise!" My Mom and dad shouted "we

up in pink!"

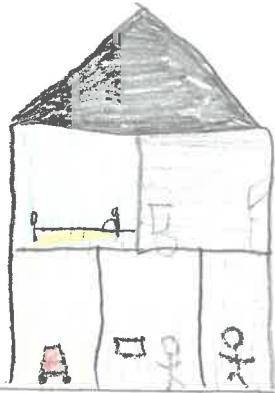
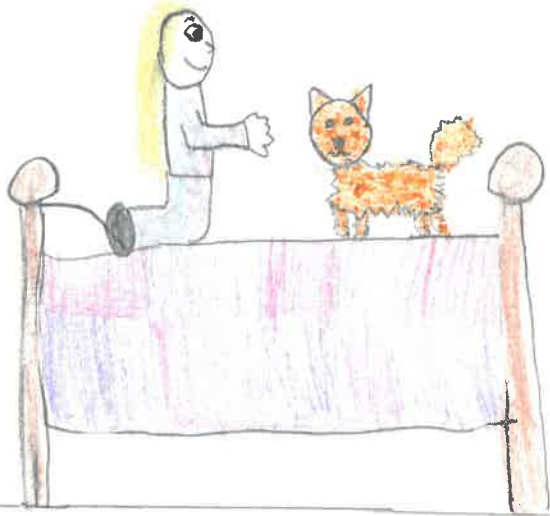
