
Casie: the detective and main character

It was another boring day for Detective Casie. Then the phone rang. *Ring!**Ring! "Detective Casie speaking," she said in a still-tired voice.




"I found a strange fossil!"

Casie drove to Holly River Campground, by the cabins. She hopped out of the car.




"Where's the fossil?" Casie asked. "Follow me," Lucy said, heading toward the ancient forest.

Chapter III: Storm




It was getting cloudy and windy. "A storm's coming! Run into the cave!" Casie cried. "Grab the fossil, Lucy!"

"Wait, Lucy!" Casie picked it up and slid it into a slot in the wall.



"Use it!" Lucy shouted with excitement.


Casie laid her hands over some hands carved into the wall next to the snake.
